SUMMARY OF DIRECTIVE FOR SELECTION AND PLACEMENT OF OVERSEAS STUDENTS AT ASSOCIATE AND UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL

ARTICLE 6 – (1) The quota of students to be admitted to the programs from abroad is determined by the Senate Decision upon proposal of the Units, provided that they do not exceed 10% of the quotas determined by ÖSYM.

(2) Quotas, application dates, admission base scores and other information are announced on NKU's website. Information such as brochures are sent to the TR Embassies in the countries from where foreign students will be accepted.

(3) Applications are made on the NKU website or in person on the dates specified in the academic calendar.

Namik Kemal University Foreign Student Selection Examination (NKU-YÖS)

ARTICLE 7 – (1) NKU International Student Selection Examination (NKU-YÖS) is held every year on the date specified in the academic calendar.

(4) NKÜ-YÖS consists of 2 separate tests, namely the Basic Learning Skills Test and the Turkish Test.

Basic Learning Skills Test is an 80-question test consisting of General Ability, Mathematics and Geometry. The Turkish Language Test is a test consisting of 60 questions that measures proficiency of candidates in Turkish language.

(5) NKÜ-YÖS Result Document is valid for 2 academic years following the exam date.

(6) NKÜ-YÖS Exam fee is determined by the University Board every year.

Preference

ARTICLE 8 – (1) The candidate who is successful over the base score announced during determination and announcement of foreign student quota of the relevant units, with a minimum of 40 points from the NKÜ-YÖS Basic Learning Skills Test, can make a choice.

(2) The candidate makes a choice on the dates specified in the academic calendar. Candidates who do not make a choice within the period will not be placed in the placement process.

(3) The candidate can choose at most five of the diploma awarding programs at NKU.

Placement

ARTICLE 10 – (1) Placement is based on the Basic Learning Skills Test score taken from the NKÜ-YÖS exam or the foreign student selection exams held in other Turkish Universities, and the placement is made by considering the order of preference of the candidates.

Proficiency in Turkish

ARTICLE 13 – (1) Candidates who are accepted to programs whose education language is Turkish must get sufficient scores from the NKÜYÖS Turkish Test, the Turkish proficiency exam or the Turkish Language Test of the Turkish Teaching Center affiliated to TR Universities in order to start their education after enrolling. The Turkish language of the candidates who completed their secondary education in Turkish high schools affiliated to the Ministry of National Education is considered sufficient.

In the Turkish proficiency exam, 70 points or more are considered A level, between 40 points and 69 points B level, and less than 40 points C level.

Candidates accepted to programs teaching in a foreign language must submit the result document of the International Foreign Language Exams accepted by the Interuniversity Board during registration. Those who cannot submit any of these documents are taken to the Foreign Language Proficiency Exam held by the NKU School of Foreign Languages.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Tekirdag Namık Kemal University Foreign Student Selection Examination (NKUYOS):

NKÜYÖS consists of 2 separate tests, namely the Basic Learning Skills Test and the Turkish Test.

Basic Learning Skills Test is an 80-question test consisting of General Ability, Mathematics and Geometry. The Turkish Language Test is a test consisting of 60 questions that measures proficiency of candidates in Turkish language.

NOTE: Candidates who get at least 40 points from NKÜYÖS can make choice.

PREFERENCE CONDITIONS FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS:

- 1) Candidates who get at least 40 points from the Namık Kemal University Foreign Student Selection Exam Basic Learning Skills Test can make a choice.
- 2) The candidate makes a choice on the dates specified in the Exam Calendar. Candidates who do not make a choice within the period will not be placed in the placement process.
- 3) The candidate can choose at most five of the diploma awarding programs at Namık Kemal University.
- 4) Candidates who are placed in any program as a result of the selection process, regardless of whether they have registered or not, cannot choose for additional placements for the vacant quotas.

Conditions of Special Aptitude Test:

- 1) Candidates who will prefer programs that admit students with Special Talent Exam are required to take NKU-YÖS.
- 2) NKU (Namik Kemal University) Registrar's Office sends the list of candidates who are eligible to take the Special Talent Exam to the relevant units. The placement of these students in Special Talent Programs is done according to the results of the Special Talent Exam.
- 3) Special Talent Exams are held on dates determined by the Rectorate according to the academic calendar.

4) The Unit Administrative Board determines special talent exam juries of the programs and conducts the exam. Special Talent Exam results are evaluated by the Unit Administrative Board.

5) Units submit the list of permanent and substitutes to the NKU Student Affairs Department, as much as the quota for foreign students announced for the programs that admit students with the Special Talent Exam.

6) Candidates who do not attend Special Talent Exam lose their right to be a student in the Special Talent Program.
