### NECMETTIN ERBAKAN UNIVERSITY'S APPLICATION CRITERIA FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

#### **Required Documents for Application**

Any application must be accompanied by documents, which are certified by the notary public of Republic of Türkiye, or by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate located in other countries, other than the documents required for the FSE (Foreign Student Exam).

- a- FSE result certificate issued by other higher education institutions recognized by Necmettin Erbakan University's Foreign Student Exam (NEUFSE), or by the Senate (Turkish translation of international or national result exam certificate (if any) together with the FSE result),
- b- Turkish translation of high school diploma,
- c- Turkish translation of official transcript (or of its version converted into hundred's system), which is certified by the high school principal to demonstrate the courses they received during the high school education, marks and grade point average,
- d-Turkish translation of the certificate showing the diploma grade,
- e- Turkish translation of education certificate issued by the school for the students that are about to graduate on the date of application.
- f- Bank receipt to indicate that application fee has been deposited,
- g- A copy of passport,

# **Application Criteria**

- 1- Clarifications on the application will be posted on the website of the University prior to the date of application.
- 2- Applications are made online on the University's website between the specified dates.
- 3- The application of such applicants who have missing documents among those documents uploaded to the system online during the application period will be disqualified.
- 4- Meeting the application criteria will not entitle applicants to be accepted for placement.

# **International Student Exam and Placement**

- 1- NEUFSE is held and administrated by the International Affairs Coordinator in different languages as the dates and locations will be set by the senate.
- 2- The exam fee is determined by the Board of the Directors of the University.
- 3- The exam contains 80 multiple-choice questions in the fields of General Ability, Mathematics and Geometry.
- 4- The placement score is calculated by taking 70% of the NEUFSE result and 30% of the equivalent exams in the hundred's system, except for the FSE as set out in Annex 1.
- 5- The applicants attend the NEUFSE, make their preference and are paced, and then if there are still vacancies, the placement will be carried by the International Affairs Coordinator on the basis of FSE of other higher education institutions recognized by the Senate (in the ratio as set out in article 10/4), international exams, national exams, central exit tests for high schools, and weighted high school grade point average, respectively.

- 6- Priority will be given to the younger applicants if the scores are equal.
- 7- If deemed necessary, additional placements may be made as second or third placement, or the vacancies may be placed into the associate degree programs and undergraduate programs demanded in excess of the number of placements by adding with the resolution of the Board of Directors of the University. However, the vacancies may be transferred with the resolution of the Higher Education Executive Board in case of the Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Law programs.
- 8- The applicants applied to the programs that accept students through special talent exam are required to pass the Special Talent Exam held by the University, in addition to the abovementioned general criteria, and the applications will be evaluated by the relevant faculty on the basis of the criteria in the registration and acceptance guidelines for special talent exam application.

## **Minimum Base Points for Application**

- 1- For the applicants to apply, they are required to score minimum 80 out of 100 on the NEUFSE for the Medicine and Dentistry programs, and 50 for other programs.
- 2- For the applicants who do not attend the NEUFSE to apply, they are required to have at least the equivalent exam points as set out in Annex 1.
- 3- The NEUFSE held by the University will be valid for two years following the exam date. The high school exit test listed in Annex 1 (such as GCE AL, International Baccalaureate, and Tawjihi) is not subject to validity limitation. However, the university admission exams (such as SAT, and Gaokao) will be valid for two years from the exam entry date.

## Language of Education and Level of Proficiency

Those students, who are placed in a program whose language of education is other than the native language of the foreign student, are required to certify that they are successful at the language of the program.

- a- The proficiency of the students placed in Turkish programs must be at least B2 (except for students who have a permit to renounce Turkish citizenship and the students who have completed their secondary education in Turkey).
- b- Students who fail to certify their Turkish Proficiency Level must be successful in the Turkish Proficiency Exam to be held by Necmettin Erbakan University, Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center.
- c- Students who are placed in programs other than Turkish are required to have an adequate score on the following exams, which are considered as equivalent by the Interuniversity Board, or to score 70 or higher on the Foreign Language Exam held by the Council of Higher Education / the Student Selection and Placement Center.

Those students who fail to certify that they are successful at the teaching language of the program will be subject to the provisions of the Regulations/Guidelines of the relevant units of the University.

Foreign students are required to certify their Turkish proficiency in minimum B2 within two years and successfully complete the preparatory class.
