

TURKISH-PREPARATION-CONDITIONS

" TÖMER Certificates" from universities in Turkey and "Turkish Proficiency Exam (TYS)" conducted by the Institute of Yunus Emre are valid for departments whos educational language is Turkish.

The student whose Turkish score is insufficient is considered to be on leave for 1 year in order to raise the level of Turkish by pre-registering for the department/program. If the student cannot obtain the sufficient level of Turkish during this period, an additional period of one year is granted with the condition that it is documented. Students that are considered to be on leave, do not pay tuition fees and can not benefit from student rights. Those who cannot obtain the required level of Turkish within allotted time will have their record deleted.

Students enter "Level Determination Exam" at the beginning of the registration period. The participant who scored 69 points or less out of 100 on this exam is placed in a "Program" at the determined level based on the "Level Determination Exam" score.

Level Determination Exam: Levels and Points Table:

A1	0-30
A2	31-45
B1	46-60
B2	61-69
C1	70-85
C2	86-100

In the associate / undergraduate / graduate programs, the student must obtain at least a level of B2 in order to be successful in the Turkish language program.
