

PASSING CRITERIA FOR TURKISH PREPARATORY

1: Conditions to commence studies in their departments based on the scores received by the Turkish Language Test provided by the university or that of equivalence:

- a) Candidates with A level Turkish may commence their studies immediately.
- b) Candidates with B level Turkish may continue their studies in their departments whilst attending compulsory Turkish courses provided by the university.
- c) Candidates with C level Turkish will be considered 'On Leave' for one year in which they are required to learn Turkish.

2: YUNUS EMRE INSTITUTE TURKISH PROFICIENCY TEST

The test is carried out in two sessions. The first session consists of Reading, Listening and Writing. Second session includes Speaking (individual and paired). First session: Reading 60, Listening 45, Writing 60 for a total of 165 minutes. Second session: Individual Speaking 5, Paired Speaking 10 for a total of 15 minutes. The total duration of the test is 180 minutes.

With the requirement scoring at least 50% (12.5 points) in each section the candidates are rewarded a B2 for scoring points between 55-70, C1 for points between 71-88 and a C2 Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate for points between 89-100.
