

CRITEREA TO PASS TURKISH PREPARATORY

GAZİ UNIVERSITY TÖMER TURKISH PROFICIENCY TEST

In order to be able to start the education, candidates who are admitted to the curriculum of which the instructional language is Turkish, must take the Turkish proficiency Test conducted within the framework of the principles determined by the TÖMER Directorate. Candidates whose Turkish level is insufficient are registered to TÖMER. Students who successfully complete one year of Turkish language education at TÖMER and pass the Turkish Proficiency Test may begin their undergraduate / undergraduate education. Candidates who fail the Turkish proficiency examination are dismissed from the University.

At TÖMER the exams are evaluated out of 100.

Year / semester grades: 30% of midterm grades and 70% of the final exam are considered as success grades. The grades calculated at the end of the exams can not be lower than 60% of the full grade.

YUNUS EMRE INSTITUTE TURKISH PROFICIENCY TEST

The test is carried out in two sessions. The first session consists of Reading, Listening and Writing. Second session includes Speaking (individual and paired). First session: Reading 60, Listening 45, Writing 60 for a total of 165 minutes. Second session: Individual Speaking 5, Paired Speaking 10 for a total of 15 minutes. The total duration of the test is 180 minutes.

With the requirement scoring at least 50% (12.5 points) in each section the candidates are rewarded a B2 for scoring points between 55-70, C1 for points between 71-88 and a C2 Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate for points between 89-100.
