

## CAPPADOCIA UNIVERSITY CRITERIA TO PASS TURKISH PREPARATORY COURSE

In order to be able to register, eligible candidates must have sufficient Turkish language levels (C or B level) in the year they gain this right. Candidates with inadequate Turkish language level (A) are obliged to increase their level of Turkish language to a sufficient level within one year which they will be granted leave of absence.

Levels According to Turkish Exam Results:

“C”Level: Student has sufficient Turkish language skills and can start education.

“B”Level: Student can improve Turkish language skills in a short time and can start education.

“A”Level: Student has inadequate Turkish language skills and one year after studying Turkish can start education.

Score Range	Level	Statement
0-29	A1	The student cannot start his / her education before reaching B1 level.
30-49	A2	
50-69	B1	The student starts his/ her education, takes Turkish lessons and is aimed to reach C1 level
70-79	B2	
80-89	C1	The student starts his / her education.
90-100	C2	

The foreign students, who entitled to register for a program which education language is Turkish, are required to attain minimum B level in Turkish Test / Turkish Proficiency Exam taken from YÖS, TÖMER, Yunus Emre Institute or Cappadocia University School of Foreign Languages.

Those with the Turkish language level (A) are given 1-year allowance to learn Turkish. However, these students are obliged to raise their Turkish level to (B) within one year. Those who are in this situation must certify that they have received a score of minimum B from the Turkish proficiency test by TÖMER, Yunus Emre Institute or Cappadocia University School of Foreign Languages.

Students who are enrolled at the Cappadocia University with an equivalent examination certificate other than YÖS, and who are considered to be sufficient in the Turkish proficiency exam by TÖMER, Yunus Emre Institute or Cappadocia University School of Foreign Languages, can start their undergraduate education.
