

**SUMMARY OF ANADOLU UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATE / UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS
APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE AND REGISTRATION DIRECTIVE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS**

Anadolu University conducts at least one higher education transfer and placement exam (ANADOLUYOS) every year for students to be accepted from abroad. The scores obtained in this exam are valid for two years. The content, method, fee and date of the exam are determined by the Board of Directors. However, the candidate can also apply to the announced quotas with "High School Diploma Grade" or "High School Graduation Exam Result" or the results of exams accepted as "Higher Education Institutions Exam" , without entering ANADOLUYOS, as specified in Article 10 of this Directive. Candidates who have not yet received their diploma must submit an official document from their high school showing the grade point average and the date they can graduate in order to be evaluated.

ANADOLUYOS consists of "General Aptitude Test" and "Turkish Language Test". The scores of two tests are calculated separately. The candidate receives the "ANADOLUYOS Exam Result Document" from the link on the University's website. After the link is removed, the "Exam Result Document" will not be reissued.

The exam booklet contains Turkish and English explanations about the exam.

For enrollment in formal departments/programs, the candidate must get at least 50 points from the "General Aptitude Test" and at least 60 points from the "Turkish Test" on the scale of 100. For the registration to the Open Education System programs, the candidate must get at least 20 points from the "General Aptitude Test" and at least 60 points from the "Turkish Test" on the scale of 100.

If necessary, ANADOLUYOS can also be done at exam centers abroad.

Candidates apply to the announced quotas with "ANADOLUYOS Exam Result Document". On the other hand, candidates who have not/have taken the exam can apply for the quotas according to the results of the exams in the status of "Higher Education Institutions Exam" or according to their "High School Diploma Grade" or "High School Graduation Exam Result", as well. In order to apply to the overseas programs of Open Education System, it is sufficient to graduate from secondary education institutions at the high school level in countries other than Turkey and the TRNC.

Candidates who, in regard with the exams in the status of Higher Education Institutions Exam;

- a) Receive a minimum of 21 points in Science Reasoning, Maths and total score in ACT,
- b) Receive at least 300 out of 350 points in Afghanistan National University Admission Exam (KONKUR-Baccaluria),
- c) Receive at least 400 out of 700 points from the Central University Admission Exam conducted by TQDK in Azerbaijan,
- d) Receive at least 60 out of 100 points in the Indonesian Ujian Akhir National (UAN) Exam,
- d) Receive at least 480 out of 750 points in the point type of applied program in the GAOKAO exam,
- e) Receive at least B3 from each of the six courses, including mathematics, in the WAEC (West African Examination Council) exam held in Nigeria,
- f) Candidates who score at least 550 points at Mathematics and 1000 points at total from Mathematics + Reading in the SAT 1 exam can apply.

Candidates, who, according to “High School Diploma Grade” or “High School Graduation Exam Result”,

a) Receive 1–4 in the ABITUR exam or the Austrian MATURA (Matura Reifezeugnis) exam (applications with FACHABITUR without exam will not be accepted),

b) Have at least 12 points of diploma grade in DIPLÔME DU BACCALAUREAT GENERAL (French Baccalaureate),

c) Have Grade A in at least two fields, one of which is related with the applied department/program, in GCE (A level),

ç) Have a Swiss MATURA diploma grade of at least 3.5 points,

d) are TRNC citizen residing at TRNC and GCE AL exam results as having completed secondary education in TRNC, and who have or will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling in colleges or high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010,

e) Have a diploma grade of at least 10 points in the Greek “Apolytirion of Lykeo/Secondary School Leaving Certificate”,

f) Have a diploma grade of at least 6 out of 10 (60 percent) or equivalent can apply.

The validity period of the exams in the status of Higher Education Institutions exam is limited to 2 years.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Exam Result Documents Accepted in Applications:

Apart from ANADOLUYOS, the candidate can apply for registration according to the exam results approved by the Council of Higher Education.

ANADOLUYÖS

Date, place and time of ANADOLUYOS: The "Application Requirements" announcement prepared within the scope of this Directive is announced on the University's website. ANADOLUYOS consists of "General Aptitude Test" and "Turkish Language Test". The scores of two tests are calculated separately. The candidate receives the "ANADOLUYOS Exam Result Document" from the link on the University's website. After the link is removed, the "Exam Result Document" will not be reissued.

The exam booklet contains Turkish and English explanations about the exam.

For enrollment in formal departments/programs, the candidate must get, out of 100 points, at least 50 points from the "General Aptitude Test" and at least 60 points from the "Turkish Test". He/she must get at least 20 points from the "General Aptitude Test" and at least 60 points from the "Turkish Test" for enrollment in open education programs.

Candidates who, in regard with the exams in the status of Higher Education Institutions Exam;

- a) Receive a minimum of 21 points in Science Reasoning, Maths and total score in ACT,
- b) Receive at least 300 out of 350 points in Afghanistan National University Admission Exam (KONKUR-Baccaluria),
- c) Receive at least 400 out of 700 points from the Central University Admission Exam conducted by TQDK in Azerbaijan,
- d) Receive at least 60 out of 100 points in the Indonesian Ujian Akhir National (UAN) Exam,
- d) Receive at least 480 out of 750 points in the point type of applied program in the GAOKAO exam,
- e) Receive at least B3 from each of the six courses, including mathematics, in the WAEC (West African Examination Council) exam held in Nigeria,
- f) Candidates who score at least 550 points at Mathematics and 1000 points at total from Mathematics + Reading in the SAT 1 exam can apply.

Candidates, who, according to "High School Diploma Grade" or "High School Graduation Exam Result",

- a) Receive 1–4 in the ABITUR exam or the Austrian MATURA (Matura Reifezeugnis) exam (applications with FACHABITUR without exam will not be accepted),
- b) Have at least 12 points of diploma grade in DIPLÔME DU BACCALAUREAT GENERAL (French Baccalaureate),
- c) Have Grade A in at least two fields, one of which is related with the applied department/program, in GCE (A level),
- ç) Have a Swiss MATURA diploma grade of at least 3.5 points,

d) TRNC citizens who reside in the TRNC and have completed their secondary education in the TRNC and have GCE AL exam results, and those who have continued education in colleges or high schools in other countries between the years 2005– 2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results.

e) Have a diploma grade of at least 10 points in the Greek “Apolytirion of Lykeo/Secondary School Leaving Certificate”,

f) Have a diploma grade of at least 6 out of 10 (60 percent) or equivalent can apply.

The validity period of the exams in the status of Higher Education Institutions exam is limited to 2 years.

SPECIAL APTITUDE TEST

Departments of Art-Handiwork Teaching, Coaching Education, Physical Education and Sports Teaching, Recreation, Printing Arts, Glass, Cartoon (Animation), Graphics, Sculpture, Painting, Ceramics, General Musicology, Wind and Percussion Instruments, Piano, Turkish Music, String Instruments, Graphic Arts, and Ceramic Arts accept students with a Special Aptitude Examination.
